



Job Title: Case Worker/Youth Service Specialist

Basic Function:

Implement direct educational and social services appropriate for high-risk, probation youth and their families in order to help youth reduce their criminal involvement and recidivism and overcome barriers to success in their family, school, community, employment and life. Programs include but are not limited to: Gang Intervention Services, Gender Specific Services in the Community, Home Based Services to High-Risk High-Needs Youth and Families; Home Based Gender Specific Services. Responsibilities:

1. Facilitate aggression replacement training and social emotional learning individually or in groups;
2. Facilitate youth development activities, mentoring activities and fieldtrips;
3. Facilitate individual assessment and case planning;
4. Implement individual and group service plans;
5. Facilitate individual and group parent education;
6. Assist in the implementation of community education forums;
7. Assist in the implementation of Case Coordination Services;
8. Provide support for transportation services for youth;
9. Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation of services;
10. Attend required meetings and trainings;
11. Provide services on a flexible schedule including evenings and weekends; and
12. Other related duties as assigned by supervisor, or as identified in program manuals or funding source contracts.

Required Education & Training:

1. Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice, Social Work, Education, Psychology, Sociology or related field, or 60 units of college credit, or equivalent experience
2. At least 1 year of related working experience with high-risk, at-risk, probation, foster care, and/or low-income youth and/or parents;
3. Experience working with diverse communities in South Los Angeles;
4. Excellent verbal and written communication skills and attention to detail in documentation;
5. Computer literate;
6. Must be able to pass the Los Angeles County Probation Department Background Check; and
7. Must have a valid California driver's license, excellent driving record, and auto insurance.

Preferred Education & Training:

1. Bachelors Degree in Criminal Justice, Social Work, Education, Psychology, Sociology or related field;
2. Bilingual in Spanish; and
3. Experience with group facilitation, & group presentations or experience with home-visitation & case management.
